I wish to address you, regarding the matter at hand as follows:

1. For the best of my knowledge, Israeli citizens, holding Israeli REGULAR passport, do not require visa in order to enter your country.
2. Please confirm, whether Israeli CITIZENS, holding Israeli PROVISIONAL passport (Laissez-Passer), rather than regular passport, may as well enter your country, without the requirement to obtain visa.
