Thank you for your email of the 24 January 2013 regarding Israeli provisional passports. I have been asked to respond to your email.

I can confirm that a citizen of the State of Israel holding an Israeli provisional passport does not have to hold a visa permitting travel to New Zealand. This is only if the person concerned is seeking a visitor visa for not more than three months and the purposes of the visit is not for medical consultation or treatment.
