Dear Mr. Gervits,

In response to your letters of November 27, 2011, and January 19, 2012, regarding visa exemption of Israeli citizens who are holders of Israeli *Travel Documents in Lieu of National Passport*, I kindly inform you that according to the provisions of Annex II of the *Council Regulation (EC) No 539/2001 of 15 March 2001 listing the third countries whose nationals must be in possession of visas when crossing the external borders, and those whose nationals are exempt from that requirement*, to which Poland is bound as a member of the Schengen Area, all Israeli citizens, both holders of regular and provisional passports, including holders of the above-mentioned travel document, are exempt from the visa requirement for intended stays not exceeding three months in any six-month period.
