**Re: Entry of Israeli Citizens Holding a Provisional Passport  
To San Marino**

Dear Sir/Madam,

We wish to address you, regarding the matter at hand as follows:

1. For the best of our knowledge, due to Visa Exemption Agreement between Israel and your country, **Israeli citizens**, holding Israeli regular passport, do not require visa in order to enter your country for short visits.
2. Please confirm, whether **Israeli citizens, holding Israeli PROVISIONAL passport** (as attached), rather than regular passport, may as well enter your country without the requirement to obtain visa.
3. We'd like to emphasize that the question is referring to Israeli CITIZENS only, in documents of whom, the NATIONALITY written is ISRAELI.
