Entry to Switzerland, Israeli Citizens Holding a Provisional Passport to Switzerland

Dear Sirs

We hereby confirm that the righteous holders of Provisional Passports of the State of Israel do not require a visa to enter Switzerland for short stay visits limited to a maximum duration of 90 days within 180 days. They require a visa, however, for stays of more than 90 days of duration.

There are obligations as well to hold a visa with regard to exercising gainful occupation:

- in the primary or secondary construction industry and civil engineering, catering and hotel services, industrial and private cleaners, surveillance and security services, and erotic services;
- gainful occupation of any another kind, if such occupation exceeds 8 days within a calendar year.
